Welcome Baby

How I made this card:

1. Cut all cardstock to size
 - Whisper White
 - 1 x (8.5" x 5.5") score at 4.25" for card base
 - 2 x (5" x 3.75") - Front diagonal panel & base panel
 - Pivot one of these panels so that it is on a diagonal equalling 1.25" and trim (I put one corner at the 1" mark and the 2.25" mark) - Keep scrap piece
 - Basic Black
 - 1 x (0.75" x 3.75")
 - Birthday Bonanza Designer Paper
 - 1 x (2.5" x 3.75")
2. Adhere designer series paper to bottom of base panel
3. Adhere large diagonal whisper white card with dimensionals to the top of the base panel
4. Stamp sentiment and emboss with white embossing powder. I used my stamparatus to make this easier to stamp!
5. Stamp baby duck (using scrap diagonal piece) with black tuxedo memento ink and colour with Stampin' Blend markers, fussy cut out.
6. Adhere sentiment strip to the white diagonal and trim
7. Adhere baby duck with Stampin' Dimensionals
8. Adhere panel to card base
